## ORDINANCE NO. 15

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR LICENSING POOL HALLS AND POOL TABLES IN THE CITY OF CLINTON, ARKANSAS, AND PROVIDING FOR THE COLLECTION OF A TAX THEREFOR.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Clinton, Arkansas:

SECTION 1. That hereafter it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to open up or operate any pool hall in the City of Clinton, Arkansas, without first obtaining a license from the Mayor and the Recorder of the City of Clinton as provided in Section 2 of this ordinance.

shall open up or operate any pool hall for the playing of pool or billiards, or charge any fee or toll for the use of any table or cue for playing pool such person, firm or corporation shall pay a license fee of \$60.00 per annum for the operation of such hall receive from the Mayor attested by the Recorder a license to open up and operate said pool hall for the term of one year next after the payment of such license. The receipt of the Treasurer shall be attached to said license at the bottom thereof and said license shall be posted in the pool hall during the time it is operated. In case of loss or destruction a copy thereof may be obtained without charge.

SECTION 3. That any person, firm or corporation who may open up or operate any pool hall in the City of Clinton, Arkansas without first paying the license fee as provided in Section 2 of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction before the Mayor shall be fined in any sum not less than \$5.00 or more than \$25.00 and each day such pool hall is operated without the payment of said license fee shall constitute a separate offense and punished accordingly.
