ORDINANCE NO. 2004- C 3

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 2003-18, TO MODIFY PROVISIONS OF THE CLINTON ZONING ORDINANCE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY TO EXIST.

WHEREAS, the City of Clinton adopted Ordinance No. 2003-18 on <u>December 11</u>, 2003; and

WHEREAS, changes in the adopted language of certain provisions of said Ordinance have been determined to be necessary to implement the intent of the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLINTON, ARKANSAS:

Section 1: Section 5-3 of Ordinance No. 2003-18 is hereby deleted in its entirety and a new Section 5-3 is adopted which reads as follows:

Plans, Architectural Drawings, or the Project Manual for buildings utilized for public assembly, to include, but not limited to, churches.theaters, public or private schools, and day care facilities must include specifications or requirements that allow the Fire Chief to determine that the structure will meet Federal and State fire codes.

Section 2: All parts of Ordinance 2003-18 not amended by this Ordinance shall remain the same.

Section 3: Emergency. The efficient operation of the City of Clinton, Arkansas, is essential to the public health, safety and welfare of its citizens. It is important that the provisions of this ordinance go into effect quickly as it imperative to make sure the zoning ordinance is properly applied to all construction projects with the City of Clinton, Arkansas. An emergency is therefore declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its adoption.
