ORDINANCE NO. 2065-19

AN ORDINANCE RECLASSIFYING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE MUNICIPAL JUDGE RETIREMENT FUND, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, The City of Clinton has adopted a Budget Ordinance for the 2005 year and for prior years that contained an appropriation for the Municipal Judge Retirement Fund; and

WHEREAS, There has been a change in said appropriation in that the funds that had been paid into the Municipal Judge and Clerk Retirement Fund that no longer need to be so allocated;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLINTON, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. The appropriation contained in the current budget is hereby amended to provide that all funds that were to be paid into the Municipal Judge and Clerk Retirement Fund are, from henceforth, to be maintained in the City's General Fund for use by the City Council for other budgetary items.

Section 2. The City Clerk is hereby directed to make this change in the 2005 Budget effective immediately.

Section 3. The efficient and harmonious use of funds available to the City of Clinton and the necessity of both maintaining a balanced budget and of providing correct budgetary information is essential to both the public welfare and to the statutory requirements placed upon the City of Clinton, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of approval.
