ORDINANCE NO. 2005-26

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE USE OF A PORTION OF THE CITY'S SALES TAX COLLECTION, ON A \$1.50 PER CUSTOMER BASIS, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SEWER SYSTEM EXPANSION

WHEREAS, the Clinton City Council passed Ordinance 2005-17 which set the rates for sewer service for the next several years, and:

WHEREAS, after Ordinance 2005-17 was passed, the Clinton City Council passed, by motion, stated its intention to segregate and spend an additional \$1.50 per customer per month from the proceeds of the sales tax collection to be used exclusively for the expansion of the Clinton Sewer System but said motion has not been incorporated into any form of ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Clinton, Arkansas, as follows:

Section 1. There shall be segregated and set aside from the revenues generated by the sales tax the sum of \$1.50 per customer per month, up to a monthly maximum of \$1500.00, with said proceeds to be used exclusively for the expansion of the Clinton Sewer System."
