ordinance no. 126

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR AND ADOPTING FOR THE CITY OF CLINTON, ARKANSAS, FOR THE TWELVE (12) MONTHS BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 1983, AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 1983; APPROPRIATING MONEY FOR EACH AND EVERY ITEM OF EXPENDITURE THEREIN PROVIDED FOR: DECLARING AN EMERGENCY TO EXIST: AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the CLINTON CITY COUNCIL has made a comprehensive study and review of the proposed budget, and

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Clinton City Council that the schedules and exhibits of financial information prepared and reviewed revealing anticipated revenues and expenditures for the calendar year appear to be as accurate as possible for budgetary purposes,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CLINTON CITY COUNCIL OF CLINTON ARKANSAS:

Section 1. This ordinance shall be known as the budget ordinance for the City of Clinton, Arkansas, for the twelve(12) month period beginning January 1, 1983 and ending December 31, 1983, reflecting estimated revenues and expenditures as hereinafter set forth on the succeeding pages. All revenues herein are estimated and subject to change and all appropriatins are calculated upon available revenues.

Section 2. The respective amounts of dunds for each and every item of expenditure classification herein proposed in the budget for 1983 are hereby approved by the City of Clinton, Arkansas, and are hereby authorized and appropriated for the purposes herein set forth for the calendar year ending December 31, 1983.

Section 3. Whereas, it is necessary for the efficient operation of Municipal Government that a budget be planned and adopted; now there fore and emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance being necessary for the preservation of public peace, health, and safety, shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
