## ORDINANCE NO. 143

## AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING RATES FOR SEWER SERVICE BY THE CITY OF CLINTON, ARKANSAS

WHEREAS, the City of Clinton, Arkansas, has determined to construct improvements and betterments to its water and sewer system (the "System") to better serve the inhabitants of the City, and to assist in financing the construction of the said improvements and betterments by the sale of its Water and Sewer Revenue Bonds, Series 1986, in the principal amount of \$961,000, and it is, therefore, necessary for the City to establish monthly rates to be charged for sewer services to be furnished by the System for the purpose of pledging the income therefrom for the payment of the said bonds.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLINTON, ARKANSAS, as follows:

 $\underline{\text{Section 1}}$ . The following rates are fixed as monthly rates to be charged for sewer services by the System:

## SEWER RATES

For each residential customer served by the System

First 1,000 gallons or less Next 1,000 gallons

All over 2,000 gallons

\$4.50 \$2.00 per 1,000 gallons or portion thereof

\$1.55 per 1,000 gallons or portion thereof

For each commercial customer served by the System

First 1,000 gallons or less, All over 1,000 gallons

\$8.00

\$1.55 per 1,000 gallons or portion thereof

The foregoing rates shall be applied on the basis of a customer's water usage.

Section 2. The invalidity of any part of this Ordinance shall not invalidate any other part thereof.

Section 3. All ordinances, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. It is ascertained and declared that the lack of an adequate water and sewer system for the needs of the City of Clinton, Arkansas, endangers the life, health, and property of the inhabitants of the City, and that in order to protect its improvements to the water and sewer system must be constructed immediately. It is, therefore, declared that an emergency exists, that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, ant that this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from November 1, 1986.
