ORDINANCE NO. 156

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT THE NEGLIGENT AND CARELESS OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES UPON THE PUBLIC STREETS OF THE CITY OF CLINTON, ARKANSAS AND OTHER PURPOSES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF CLINTON, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to operate a motor vehicle within the city limits of Clinton, Arkansas, at a speed greater than \_25\_ miles per hour, unless otherwise posted.

SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to operate a motor vehicle within the city limits of Clinton, Arkansas, in a negligent and careless manner, thereby disturbing the peace of the City, and endangering the personal and property interests of the citizens of said City. Such negligent and careless operation of motor vehicles includes but is not limited to squealing tires on street pavement; making excessive noise due to defective mufflers or absence of mufflers; and repeatedly turning a vehicle in circles upon the streets or business parking lots when not necessary for normal driving purposes.

SECTION 3. Any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be subject to a fine not to exceed  $\frac{100.00}{}$  dollars.

All ordinances and parts of ordinances in SECTION 4: conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5: It is hereby declared that the safe operation of motor vehicles in the City of Clinton can be achieved only by the provisions of this Ordinance. Therefore, it is hereby declared that an emergency exists and this Ordinance is necessary to preserve the peace, health, and safety, and therefore shall be in force from and after the date of its passage.
