

ORDINANCE NO. 92-202

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT  
SPECIFIC ACTIVITIES ON HALLOWEEN

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF CLINTON, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. In addition to other state and city penal laws and ordinances pertaining to criminal activity, disorderly conduct or damage to property, it shall be unlawful to throw or place any eggs, manure, water balloons, soap, or any other substance, trash, rubbish, or any nuisance, nauseous or offensive matter on any private or public property, regardless of damaged caused by said activity.

Section 2. Should any person be stopped and detained upon reasonable suspicion of committing any criminal offense after <sup>5<sup>00</sup></sup> 7:00 p.m. on Halloween night and have in his or her possession such items as raw eggs, manure, water balloons, or soap it shall be presumed that such person is about to engage in activity that constitutes an attempt to violate the provisions of Section 1 of this Ordinance. In such cases, said items hereinabove listed shall be seized by the detaining officer and confiscated.

Section 3. Any person violating the provisions of Section 1 of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a Misdemeanor and subject to payment of a fine of not less than \$ 25.00 nor more than \$ 250.00 for each violation. Any person attempting to violate the provisions of Section 2 of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a Misdemeanor and subject to the payment of a fine of \$ 10.00.

Section 4. It is hereby found that the activities of persons on Halloween constitute an imminent danger to the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Clinton and their property; and that an emergency therefore exists; and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
