ORDINANCE NO. 93-210

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A SPECIAL USE PERMIT

WHEREAS, the Clinton Board of Zoning Adjustment has conducted a public hearing on the application of the Family Recreation Center by Tom Griggs for a permit for a non-profit recreation facility dated April 16, 1993, which hearing was held on June 17, 1993; and

WHEREAS, said Zoning Board met and considered the issuance of a permit at a meeting on June 22, 1993, at which they concluded that a Special Use Permit for said recreation facility should be issued with certain specific conditions which were submitted to the Clinton City Council by written report; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Clinton held a special meeting on June 24, 1993 to consider said recommendation by the Zoning Board;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLINTON, ARKANSAS:

- 1. That a Special Use Permit is herewith granted for the Family Recreation Center located on U. S. Highway 95 E as a result of the application for a building permit dated April 16, 1993, provided that said permit shall be subject to and contingent upon compliance with the following described conditions:
 - 1. That separate one-way exit and entrance driveways be constructed in such a manner as to cause minimum traffic congestion and inconvenience to neighboring landowners. The construction of said driveways shall be subject to the approval of the Clinton Zoning Official.
 - 2. All exterior signs and advertisement are subject to the approval of the Clinton Zoning Official.
 - 3. The facility must be operated as a non-profit facility. There shall be no entry charges to users of the facility. Funds collected shall be by donation only. [Said condition shall remain in effect if and when the facility is used or rented to others.]
 - 4. The facility shall be in compliance with all applicable local, state and federal fire and health laws and regulations.
 - No alcoholic beverages shall be served or consumed at the facility.

- 6. There must be an assigned representative of the Board at all functions at the facility to ensure compliance of facility rules and to serve as a liaison with residents of the immediate neighborhood.
- 7. There shall be no outdoor musical activities at the site of the facility. Music must be played indoors.
 - 8. The facility shall not operate after 10:30 p.m. on Sunday through Thursday nor after 12:01 a.m. on Fridays and Saturdays.
