ORDINANCE NO. 33

AN ORDINANCE FIXING A PRIVILEGE TAX OR OCCUPATION TAX FOR THE RIGHT TO OPERATE A BUSINESS IN THE CITY OF CLINTON, ARKANSAS.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the Incorporated City of Clinton, that:

SECTION 1. All Real Estate Brokers shall pay an annual tax of \$25.00 plus five dollars (\$5.00) each for salesmen operating through his office.

SECTION 2. All Service Stations with not more than 3 pumps shall pay an annual tax of \$25.00 plus five dollars (\$5.00) per year for each pump over three. Cafes, Automobile Business or other Businesses operated in connection, shall be considered as a separate business.

SECTION 3. All other businesses of any kind or character, shall pay an annual tax of \$25.00.

Any person or persons, firm or corporation, except U. S. Post Office, or other government agencies or county or state offices, who fail to pay the above tax shall be fined not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$50.00 and each day shall constitute a separate offense.

This ordinance shall become effective when passed by the City Council and published in the Van Buren County Democrat.
