ORDINANCE NO. 39

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING A GARBAGE TAX.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Clinton, Arkansas:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby levied a garbage tax of 50 cents per month on each householder of the City of Clinton. Said monies shall be used to hire a person or persons to remove the rubbish from the homes of the city.

SECTION 2. There is levied a tax of \$1.00 per month against each store, shop, cafe or other business, said monies to be used in the same manner as provided in SECTION 1. above.

SECTION 3. The City Council shall receive bids for the removal of said garbage or refuse and shall award a contract to the lowest and best bidder each year on or before July 1st each year.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect on and after July 1st, 1948, said tax must paid quarterly, semi-annually or annually to the City Clerk, who will issue receipts for same and any householder or business operator who violates the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined in any amount not to exceed \$25.00 and cost.
