ORDINANCE NO. 4

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT RECKLESS DRIVING IN THE INCORPORATED TOWN OF CLINTON, ARKANSAS, AND FIXING PUNISHMENT FOR SAME.

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Incorporated town of Clinton, Arkansas, that:

SECTION 1. (A) Any person who drives any vehicle or automobile in such manner as to indicate either a wilful or wanton disregard for the safety of persons or property is guilty of reckless driving.

Every person convicted of reckless driving shall be punished upon first conviction by a fine of not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$500.00, or by imprisonment for a period of not less than five days nor more than 90 days or by both such fine and imprisonment, and on a second or subsequent conviction, shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$1,000.00, or by imprisonment for not less than 10 days nor more than six months or by both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication.

This ordinance was approved on the nineteenth day of April, 1938, and published on the twenty-first day of April, 1938.
