## ORDINANCE NO. 62

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING A LICENSE FEE TO BE PAID BY TRANSIENT OR ITINERANT AUCTIONEERS IN THE CITY OF CLINTON, ARKANSAS; PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLINTON, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Any person, firm or corporation who engages in a temporary, transient, or itinerant business of conducting an auction for the sale and delivery of goods, wares and merchandise within the City of Clinton, Arkansas, shall first obtain a license therefore from the City Recorder. The fee for such license shall be as follows:

Per six months, \$100.00; per month, \$50.00; per week, \$25.00.

SECTION 2. Any person, firm, or corporation who engages in the temporary, transient, or itinerant business of conducting an auction in the City of Clinton, without first obtaining a license as required by this ordinance shall be punished by a fine not to exceed the sum of \$50.00.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
