ORDINANCE NO. 65

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT PEDDLING ON CERTAIN STREETS IN THE CITY OF CLINTON.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Clinton, Arkansas:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to park a vehicle on the right-of-way of certain streets of the City of Clinton for the purpose of peddling wares of any kind, as follows:

MAIN STREET, from Highway 65 east to City Limits,
GRIGGS STREET, from Highway 65 north to Church Street,
COURT STREET, from Highway 65 north to Church Street,
BOYKIN STREET, from Highway 65 north to Church Street,
MOSS STREET, from Highway 65 north to Main Street,
WALNUT STREET, from Boykin Street east to Moss Street,

SECTION 2. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction, shall be fined in any sum of not less than \$1.00 nor more than \$10.00.

SECTION 3. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. The congested condition of parking areas on Maine, Griggs, Court, Boykin, Moss, and Walnut streets and their proximity to public buildings result in a traffic hazard when vehicles are parked thereon for the purpose of peddling. An emergency is, therefore, declared and this ordinance being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
