## ORDINANCE NO. 69

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING A TAX LEVY ON WATER AND SEWER CONSUMERS

WHEREAS, the City of Clinton, Arkansas, has had in operation for more than ten years a city owned water works system and had been furnishing water to the residences and businesses in the City, and

WHEREAS, many of said residences and businesses have no alternate source or supply of water, and

WHEREAS, the year 1963 was one of low rainfall, and the City's water reservoir was unable to supply the needs of the customers of the water works system, and

WHEREAS, a serious hazard to the health of the people of the City of Clinton was imminent if water was not obtained from another source, and

WHEREAS, the City of Clinton and its water works system caused a pipe line to be laid and pumps to be installed to obtain water from another location, thereby incurring obligations which the City and its water works system are unable to pay from its normal revenues and to fulfill its other obligations,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Clinton, Arkansas:

SECTION 1. That there be and there is hereby levied special temporary fees upon the water customers of the Clinton Water Works, said special temporary fees being in the following amounts:

For customers whose water bill for one month is:

er on an land	\$1.00
\$5.00 or less	
\$5.01 to \$10.01	\$1.50
\$10.01to \$15.01	\$2.00
\$15.01 to \$20.01	\$2.50
\$20.01 to \$50.01	<b>\$3.</b> 50
More than \$50.01	\$5.00

SECTION 2. That said fees are to be added to the statement of each waterworks customer each month, beginning with the statements prepared and mailed to said customers on or about February 1, 1964; and that said fees are to be collected by said water works and used by it.

SECTION 3. That the special temporary fees levied by this ordinance shall be collected for a period of twelve consecutive months; and thereafter, the said fees shall not be levied or collected from any water works customer.
