AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH PURCHASING POWERS AND LIMITATIONS IN TRANSACTIONS BETWEEN THE CITY OF CLINTON AND MEMBERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY AND TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 157

WHEREAS, City Recorder Charles Hicks has an ownership interest in business pertaining to welding and general repair of equipment and goods, and WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City that the City be permitted to make purchases of services and supplies from this business, and
